
What does verse 6 teach about how we became a Christian?



What does Paul pray for in verse 9?




Why does Paul pray these things? (v10-11)




If you asked a group of Christians the question 'How do you become a Christian?' what answer would they give? Is this the same or different to the answer given in Philippians?
