


What is Paul's ambition in life? (v12, 14, 18)




Why might this be a surprising ambition for Paul to have? (v13, 15-17)




Even though he is in a tough situation, why can Paul still rejoice? (v13, 14, 18, 21)






Why would Paul be happy to stay alive? (v22, 24-26)


