



How do you think your friends and family would respond if you completely stopped complaining and grumbling?

Pray for each other that God would work out His salvation in our lives, and that we would shine like stars to the world around us.


LEARN

EXPLORE

What things can make us complain and argue?

In Philippians 2:12-30 Paul shows us the transforming effect Christ has in our lives.

What is it that makes us shine like a star? (v15-16)
