The story so far...

Paul writes this letter as an apostle to those who are saints and faithful to Jesus in Ephesus.

He begins by praising God the Father for blessing them with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

He then tells them that he regularly thanks God for His work in their lives and is praying for them that their eyes would be opened to see Jesus and know Him better and that they would know all that is theirs in Him.
